PROJECT: OVERVIEW

• 300 children across Sheffield have a feeding tube, many of whom were using single-use containers

Reusable bottles could:

- Improve family living environments by freeing up space in their homes
- Improve patient and family safety in their own homes
- Positively impact environmental sustainability
- Reduce single use plastic
- Improve uptake of recycling



Standard monthly delivery of single-use containers for one child!



OPT-OUT TO STAY GREEN





- Feedback from parents was positive
- > A reduction of **4224kg CO₂e**
- Equivalent to 10.5 trees, 204,000 smartphone charges, or 4,250 miles driven by an average petrol-powered passenger vehicle



RESULTS
