

## Food Hygiene Training

As part of the SENr competency framework, practitioners must understand and apply the legal and ethical responsibilities of professional practice, exercising a duty of care to clients including adherence to child protection and safeguarding legislation or policies (Essential B2.1, p10)

An essential requirement for all applicants is evidence of completion of a recognised Level 2 Award in Food Safety in Catering as a minimum standard in this area.

### Level 2 Award in Food Safety in Catering

The SENr advises registrants to attend a face to face training course where possible which typically last for 1 day and allows for more interactive discussion on the practical considerations. Many local authorities and FE colleges provide a formal training course.
